<b>APPLICATION DEADLINES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Fall semester : June 1st</li> <li>- Spring semester : November 1st</li> </ul>
<b>APPLICATION DOCUMENTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- A nomination letter/e-mail from the home school;</li> <li>- The <a href="#">application form</a> filled and signed ;</li> <li>- An art portfolio in pdf format ;</li> <li>- A letter of motivation of the applicant presenting a short description of his/her current artistic work, explains why he/she wants to study at Beaux-Arts and specify the studio that he/she wishes to join ;</li> <li>- A resume ;</li> <li>- A copy of the passport ;</li> <li>- A photo (jpeg)</li> </ul>
<b>LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT</b>	<p>No minimum, but it is advised to have some notions of French.</p> <p>NB : Theoretical courses are taught in French.</p>
<b>SELECTION PROCESS</b>	<p>After receiving the applications, Beaux-Arts Paris organizes a selection committee - the applicants will receive an e-mail confirming their acceptance to the school 3 weeks after the application deadline.</p>

<b>LEARNING AGREEMENT</b>	<p>Exchange students participate in the common course programme and must take 4 course units (unités de cours, "UC") during the semester spent at Beaux-Arts for a total of 30 credits :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Studio - Artistic Practice Department : 16 credits</li> <li>- Technical Skills : 6 credits</li> <li>- Elective Course* : 6 credits</li> <li>- French Language Course** : 2 credits</li> </ul>

	<p><i>*May be chosen from courses in Technical Skills, Drawing Section, Print-making Bookmaking Section, Digital Technologies Section.</i></p> <p><i>**Instead of French language course, French-speaking students must take a Theoretical Study UC.</i></p>
<b>GRADING SYSTEM &amp; TRANSCRIPT OF RECORDS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- The Beaux-Arts study programme follows a curriculum based on the European Credit Transfer System (E.C.T.S.)</li> <li>- Pass or Fail : Beaux-Arts Paris does not provide grades or marks</li> </ul>
<b>FRENCH LESSONS</b>	French as a Foreign Language lessons (3 hours per week) are mandatory for the non French-speaking students during their whole exchange semester.
